2010 SpeedWeeks Quick Notes

- This may be Florida, but it does get cold in the winter. Bring jackets, hats, gloves, etc.
- Expect to pay premium pricing, after all you are seeing premium racing.
- On the dirt side of things, this is generally your one big chance to see drivers from all over the country in one spot on multiple nights.
- East Bay and USAC – be there.
- DO NOT pay extra at Volusia Speedway Park for a pit pass. The upgrade is supposed to be free this year. Conversely, expect congestion in the pits.
- Take advantage of trying to meet your favorite drivers in the pits. They are generally relaxed since most of them look at this as a “working vacation.” Be wise and wait until the night’s action is over however.
- If you are taking in the mini sprint action, as always, ladies, we ask that you wait until the feature is over before asking our Editor at Speed “The Hot Foot” Brian Penrose to autograph your undergarments.

- You generally see the same cast of characters regardless of WoO or ASCoC sanction.
- Be on the lookout for plenty of PA Posse drivers slugging out with the WoO regulars and “true outlaws” like Terry McCarl, Sammy Swindell, etc. that race when and where they please.
- USAC at East Bay is a must. Just be there.
- The “King of the 360s” is another must at East Bay, which is February 27.
- If you can make the haul, hit up Hendry County. Rumor is most of your USAC teams will be there to shake down their cars.
- If you’re into this sort of thing, you’ll see a few NAŞCAR drivers wandering the pits at VSP.
- The midway at VSP rules, so bring plenty of cash to spend.

Charlotte County Motorsports Park 28000 Airport Rd Punta Gorda, FL 941-575-7223	Look for our safety editor Scotty Adema in competition. Also be on the lookout for teenage sensation Amanda Ferguson. Be sure to take in the FMARA. Bobby Bucks are no longer valid.
Citrus County Speedway 3600 South Florida Avenue Inverness, FL (352) 726-9339	Tempers will flare at this tight track. Guaranteed. Dude Teate and Bo Hartley could be drivers to watch. International drivers? At Citrus County? Could be... Get the egg rolls. Seriously. Ice cream is good too!
Desoto Speedway 21000 E State Road 64 # A Bradenton, FL 34212-8600 941-748-3171	Hopefully they have cut the grass in the off season. There is a Publix on the other side of the Interstate - get a sub. Ask them how much they want for the place - they might sell! TBARA always puts on a good show.
East Bay Raceway Park 6311 Burts Road Tampa, FL 813-677-7223	The most expensive burger in the state - but worth it. Easy to get to, yet off the beaten path...you'll see. Tempers can and do flare at, "The Clay by the Bay." Buy some sweets from the nice lady over in the midway area.
Hendry County Motorsports Park 1001 N US Highway 27 Clewiston, FL 863-983-3478	Southernmost racetrack - enough said Racetrack food award winner - get the BBQ. Catch the USAC crowd as they tune up for East Bay. Get comfortable, you'll be driving a while. Try our podcast!
New Smyrna Speedway 3939 State Road 44 West New Smyrna Beach, FL 32168 386-427-4129	They have Yuengling! That's all you need to know. Try the potato pancakes and other oddball food offerings. Given the proximity to the big track down the road...drivers galore! Watch Troy DeCaire and Dave Steele work traffic in 3 & 4.
Ocala Speedway 9050 Northwest Gainesville Road Ocala, FL 352-622-9400	Best chili cheese dog in the state - buy it. Super friendly track management. Getty ready for the dust! Pretty easy track to get to, no matter the direction.
Volusia Speedway Park 1500 State Road 40 De Leon Springs, FL 386-985-4402	Check the midway - best one in the state all year. Look for the dude selling cheesesteaks from Pennsylvania. Get there early, it gets crowded quick. Bring something to protect your eyes if you are sitting in the turns.
